The SHRESHTA (NETS)—(NETS) comprises of one paper having four sections of Mathematics, Science and Social Science, General Awareness / Knowledge. The Paper is conducted for admission in best private residential schools in the country under Residential Education for students in High Schools in targeted areas.

The paper will be based on NCERT syllabus of class-VIII for admission in class-IX and class-X syllabus for admission in class-XI.

The SHRESHTA (NETS) will be conducted for admissions in classes 9th and 11th only for SC candidates whose parental annual income is upto ₹ 2.5 lacs.

### ○ Mode of Examination

SHRESHTA (NETS) will be conducted in pen and paper mode (offline).

# YASASVI ENTRANCE TEST

## ○ General Instructions

YASASVI ENTRANCE TEST (YET) is an Examination for selection of eligible candidates for award of scholarships under the YASASVI Scheme.

- (i) The YET will be conducted for award of scholarships to **OBC, EBC and DNT** candidates studying in Class 9 in identified Top Schools.
- (ii) Merely appearing in YET or qualifying the same does not confer any right to the candidate for award of scholarships.
- (iii) The selection and award of scholarship is subject to fulfilling the eligibility Criteria, Eligibility, Rank in Merit List, verification of original documents and such other criteria as may be prescribed by the concerned Government(s) under the Scheme.
- (iv) Applications of candidates submitting false and fabricated information will be rejected and such candidates will be further debarred from appearing in examinations conducted by NTA.
- (v) NTA reserves the right to withdraw permission granted inadvertently (if any), to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the YET-2023, even though the Admit Card had been issued by the NTA.
- (vi) In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions / terms / rules / criteria regarding determination of eligibility / conduct of examination / registration of candidates / information contained therein, the interpretation of the NTA / MoSJ&E (as the case may be), shall be final and binding.

YET will be conducted in Paper pen mode (OMR based).
