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General Information

The CRPF will conduct an open competitive examination for recruitment of Indian citizens against vacancies prescribed for Male and Female candidates who are ordinarily residents of their respective States/UTs to fill up the vacancies of Constable (Technical & Tradesmen and Pioneer) in Central Reserve Police Force as per the Recruitment Scheme/Rules formulated by the Ministry of Home Affairs/CRPF.

● **NATIONALITY / CITIZENSHIP :**

Candidates must be a citizen of India.

● **AGE LIMIT :**

For Constable : 21-27 years as on 01/01/2026. Candidates should not have been born earlier than 02/01/1999 and later than 01/01/2005.

● **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS (AS ON 01/01/2026) :**

As per the Official Notification.

● **COMPUTER BASED TEST (CBT) :**

(a) The Computer Based Test will consist of one objective type paper containing 100 questions carrying 100 marks, with the following composition :

A	General Intelligence and Reasoning	25	25	
B	General Knowledge and General Awareness	25	25	02 Hours
C	Elementary mathematics	25	25	
D	English/Hindi	25	25	

(b) All questions will be of Objective Multiple-Choice Type. The CBT will be conducted in English and Hindi only.

(c) There will be NEGATIVE MARKING OF 0.25 MARKS for each wrong answer. Candidates are, therefore, advised to keep this in mind while answering the questions.

(d) The date & Centre of Computer Based Test (CBT) will be informed to candidates via Admit Card only through the website of the CRPF.

(e) There shall be no provision for re-evaluation/re-checking of the scores. No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.

- (f) Marks scored by candidates in Computer Based Test (CBT) will be normalized and such normalized scores will be used to determine final merit list and cut off marks.
- (g) The questions in the CBT will be of Matriculation level.
- (h) Candidates are not permitted to use calculators and other electronic gadgets. They should not, therefore, bring the same inside the Examination Hall.
- (i) **The syllabus for the Examination will be as follows :**

- 1. General Intelligence and Reasoning :** Analytical aptitude and ability to observe and distinguish patterns will be tested through questions principally of non-verbal type. This component may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, spatial visualization, spatial orientation, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non-verbal series, coding and decoding etc.
- 2. General Knowledge and General Awareness :** Question in this component will be aimed at testing the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of every day observations and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic Science, General Policy, Indian Constitution, Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.
- 3. Elementary Mathematics :** This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of whole numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and loss, Discount, Mensuration, Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and work etc.
- 4. English / Hindi :** Candidate's ability to understand basic English/Hindi and his/her basic comprehension would be tested.

● **COURT'S JURISDICTION :**

Any dispute in regard to this recruitment will be subject to courts having jurisdiction over the place of concerned Examination Centres where the candidate has appeared for the PET/PST. It has been decided that after declaration of final result, the CRPF or the firm who conduct CBT, will make available scores and ranking of the candidates in the recruitment examination on its portal.
